

Information Required for Membership Applications to UCGIS

Membership in UCGIS is open to academic and research organizations and institutions with programs and missions consistent with the purposes of UCGIS. This application enables UCGIS Delegates to better understand the applicant Department/Center or Institution. The application process itself also creates an opportunity for the applicant Department/Center or Institution to collect, organize, and synthesize this type of campus-wide or department-wide information.

A. Administrative Information

- 1. Institutional **Member Type Requested** (Regular Full, Regular Basic, or Affiliate) (see website for information on these types)
- 2. Primary Delegate Information (name, email, phone, title, department)
- 3. Financial Contact Info (person who will receive a Dues invoice annually) (name and email)
- 4. Secondary Delegate Information (only for Full memberships) (name, email, phone, title, department)
